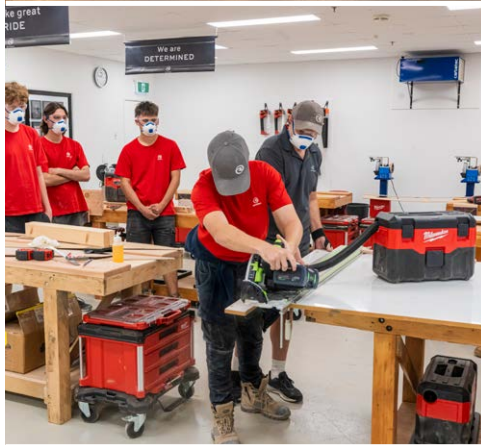

Riviera's Apprentice program commenced in the early 1990s and has since trained innumerable tradespeople. Our philosophy is that in order for Riviera to grow, we will always need to train the highest quality boat builders.

The vision of the academy is a world class facility for world class people. This is recognised by two "halls of fame" honouring Riviera's past graduated apprentices who now hold key roles within the company and an impressive showcase of Riviera's national and international awards of excellence.

Riviera's onsite training apprenticeship program exceeds industry standards and teaches the latest industry technology and techniques. Our program is designed to **"Train to Retain"** and 90% of our apprentices come through the School Based apprenticeship program.

- A supportive environment with onsite trainers and mentors across the site for apprentices to access

Propel Excellence Program

The two types of apprenticeships available

School-Based Apprenticeships



A school-based apprenticeship means that you can start your vocational training, get hands on experience while finishing school and earn a wage (yes, you get paid to learn). You might also be able to work extra hours for us during your school holidays to build your experience.

A school-based apprenticeship means that you are getting on-the-job experience, while getting qualified before you have even finished school. School-based apprenticeships are our main source of apprentice recruitment.

Our main intake of students commences in January, when they start Year 12.

Full-Time Apprenticeships

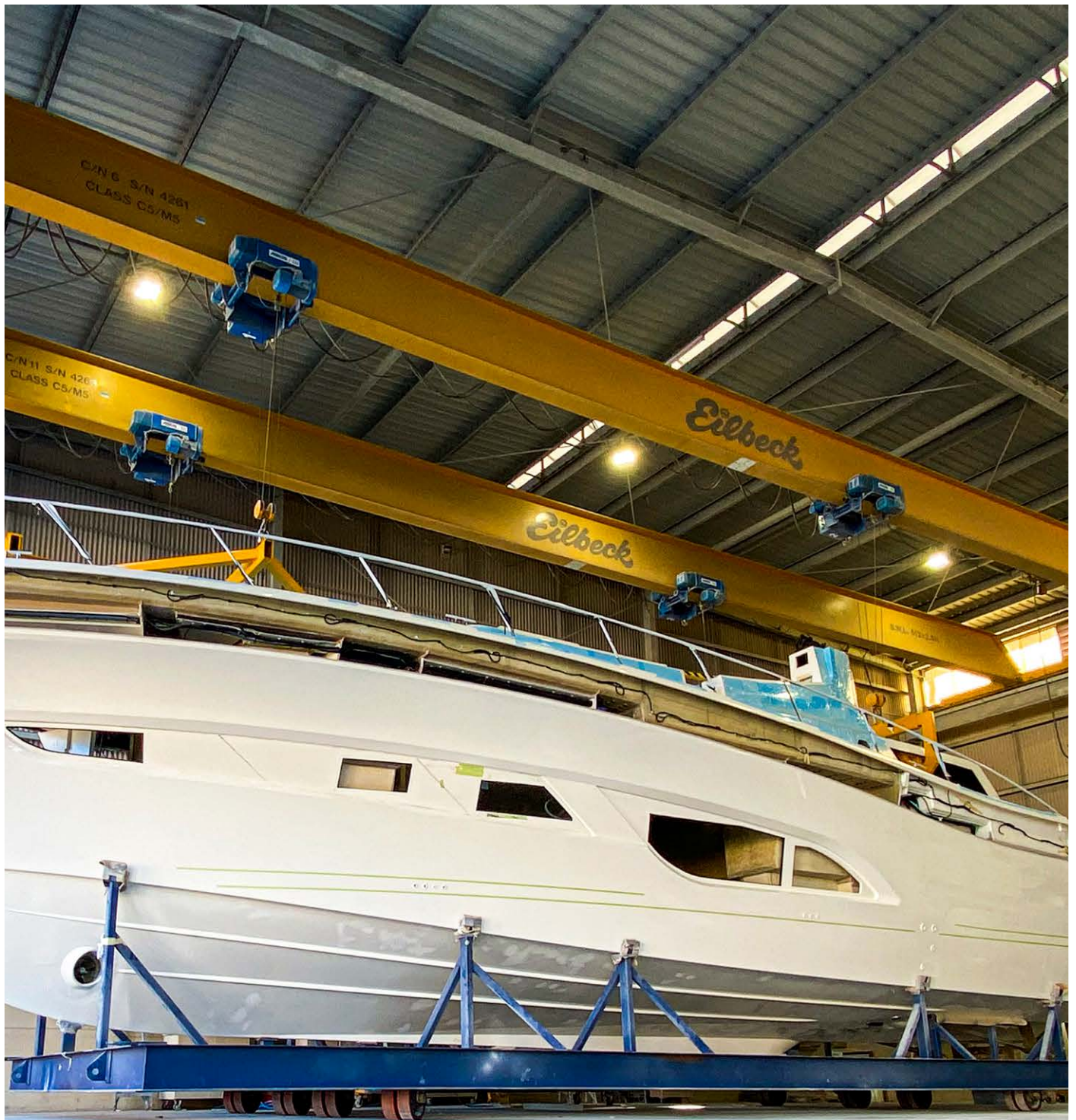


Have you finished school and are deciding your next move?

The 10 apprenticeships offered by Riviera

Polymer Processing (Composites) Certificate III



Our polymer processing apprenticeship is your pathway to a career as a trade-qualified composite technician in an industry that is in demand. We take raw materials then convert them into high-quality finished major parts, such as our ocean-going hulls, decks, and almost all other components on our world-class luxury motor yachts.

At Riviera, we design all our craft using CAD programs onsite, and our composite technicians take these designs from the computer screen and turn them into the parts that will be assembled into an award-winning motor yacht. You will learn how to build each part, including plugs, patterns and moulds, which are used to produce the structure of every Riviera motor yacht.

As a polymer processing apprentice, you will gain knowledge and understanding of how to prepare and maintain a mould for use. You will use a chopper gun and undertake structural reinforcement of parts in our production system.

Additionally, your polymer processing apprenticeship will include other disciplines, such as composite repair, infusion and resin transfer moulding (RTM) and you will be introduced to resin infusion, an innovative process with advanced manufacturing practices for which Riviera is widely recognised as an industry leader.

Marine Craft Construction Certificate III



Start your career at Riviera with an exciting marine craft construction apprenticeship. Each day you will be learning and working alongside master craftspeople building our world-class luxury motor yachts.

Marine craft construction apprentices gain hands-on skills in trade drawing, material science, and composites and timber construction. You will also gain experience in repair and maintenance procedures associated with various construction methods. Your hands-on training is delivered by our all-star team at our world-class manufacturing facility. All apprentices start their training in the first stage of construction, learning how to assemble the superstructure, and then progress into other areas of the business, such as aftermarket installations, new product development, and high-end interior fit out.

Your training plan can even include working with our waterfront quality control department. Each step of the way you will be working on multimillion-dollar motor yachts readying to be handed over to new owners all over the world.

Engineering Diesel Fitter Certificate III



Do you see yourself working on the installation of brand-new diesel engines, but also have a passion for boating and being on the water? Combine both of those together to work on a three-story, high-end building that travels at 30 knots. Getting started in diesel fitting you will become specialised and gain technical skills that are in high demand. You will learn to install, maintain and complete sea trials on our luxury motor yachts.

Being an engineering diesel fitter apprentice, you will be trained to use precision tooling to install systems and components according to industry and Riviera standards. You will be working alongside qualified tradespeople who will teach you about plumbing, installation of generators, engines, vessel stabilisation, and other key onboard systems. Then you will learn to test these systems through our quality control processes between fit-out stages and during sea trials.

Timber and Composites Machining Certificate III

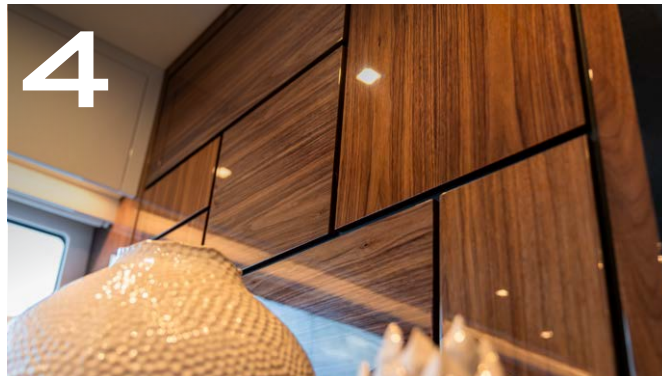


Are you someone who enjoys working with computers?

Do you pay attention to the finer details? Do you have a passion for creating things? If this sums you up and you are also great at time management, have excellent problem-solving skills, are a team player with a great work ethic and have the ability to adapt, we are looking for you to join our timber and composites machinist team as an apprentice.

You will be being trained to use state of the art CNC machinery, programming of these machines, and cutting, and creating kits from advanced manufacturing materials.

Cabinetmaking (Furniture) Certificate III



Do you like working with your hands, starting with a raw material and making it into something of high quality? Would you like to gain skills working with timber to create a superior luxury product being installed onto multimillion-dollar motor yachts? You will build galleys, staterooms and bathrooms all while working alongside master craftspeople.

You will receive hands-on training on the production floor and in the classroom, you will learn processes from design through to production, including manual and computer aided drawings, using power tools and woodworking machines and undertaking jobs within cost and time constraints.

Engineering Fabrication Certificate III



Riviera employs only the best apprentices who strive to achieve world-class standards, have an eye for detail, build for strength and understand the need to keep to our growing production schedule.

Undertaking a light fabrication trade qualification with Riviera involves working on stainless structures for three-story, high-end luxury apartments that can travel at 30 knots on the water. You will learn how to interpret technical drawings, mark off and fabricate steel and other metal stock, to make metal products and structures that are installed on our luxury motor yachts. Imagine what you could build when you have these skills.

Engineering Surface Finishing Certificate III

Qualified marine industrial spray painters are in high demand and the future is bright for those wishing to undertake this trade and develop the skills to produce the world-class finishes our motor yachts are renowned for.

Upholstery Certificate III

You will be working alongside some of Riviera's finest craftspeople with years of experience and knowledge behind them.

If you have a passion for creating, having an eye for the finest detail, working with a variety of fabrics and materials, then this apprenticeship is for you. Your hands-on training with passionate trainers and master craftspeople is conducted onsite.

Furniture Finishing (French Polishing) Certificate III

Electrotechnology - Certificate III (Certificate II in Electrotechnology – prerequisite)



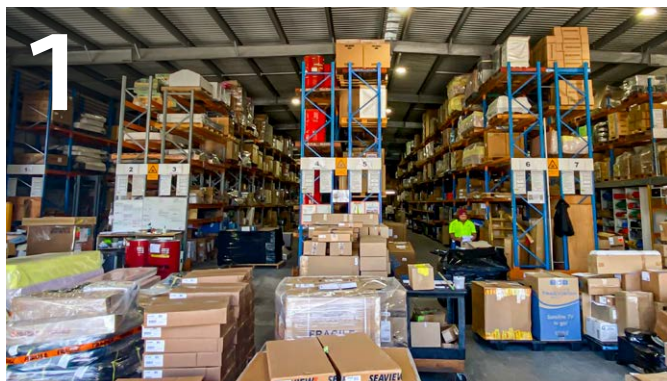

As part of your training, you will also gain skills to interpret electrical drawings, develop circuits, install and maintain electrical components, wiring, equipment and system installations.

Supply Chain Operations Certificate III

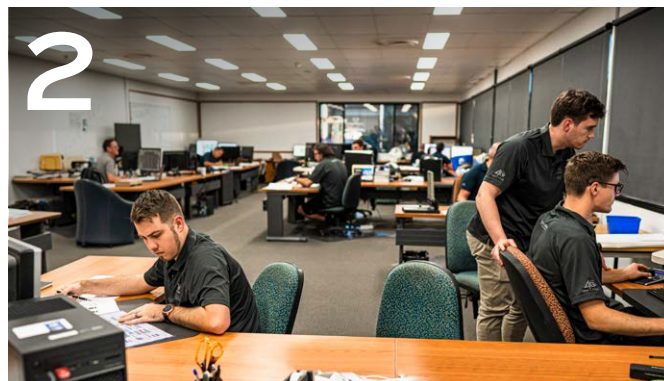

INTERVIEW PROCESS

Following a successful work experience week, students are invited to attend an interview.

Congratulations! Students who are successful, and are starting Year 12, will receive a written offer to join the school-based apprenticeship program.
